

EXPECTATIONS

- Daily attendance at practice is expected, including Spring Break
- Boatings are done based on athletic ability (to include technique), attitude, and attendance. Coaches have the final say. Decisions are not personal, but meant to make the best boats possible.
- Tryouts are 2/19-2/21. Athletes need to attend if they would like to be considered for the team. Cuts are expected to happen.
- 1v8+ and 2v8+ athletes rowing in championship events at VSRC (States) earn varsity letters
- Stotesbury is attended by select boats only
- SRAA (Nationals) is attended by those boats that qualify using SRAA's qualification rubric. The 1V must qualify for any other boat to attend.
- Athletes have access to current data so know where they are on the team.




SEEKING BOARD MEMBERS!




UNIFORMS

If you have not placed your order for uniforms, please do so as soon as possible.

Each athlete has 2 required items:

- A Uniform (boys \$85 / girls \$90)
- A Cold Weather Training Shirt (boys \$60 / girls \$60)

A special note: we are sensitive to the fact that the orders for required uniforms are placed prior to tryouts. If an athlete does not make the team, the MCC board has voted to refund in full the price of uniforms that are ordered.







BOATHOUSE JACKET

- For all those rowers who waited to order a boathouse jacket until you knew you were committed to crew your time to order is now. We will be placing a boathouse order in the next few weeks. We do need a minimum order of 6.
- What is a boathouse jacket? A pullover style, mid weight GoreTex waterproof jacket with MCLEAN CREW on the back and your name monogramed on the front. AKA a really cool crew jacket that keeps you dry on rainy days and just looking awesome on non-rainy days.
- **How must does it cost?** \$256.50 please note due to personalization all orders are final and cannot be returned. This is an optional uniform purchase.
- How do I order? Purchase through the McLean Crew Store
- When will I receive my jacket? The estimation is 6-8 weeks from order placement.

POST-TRYOUT PRACTICES

PRACTICE SCHEDULE

- 3pm 7pm Door to Door (MHS to MHS)

- Bus transportation is provided, and athletes can keep items on the bus during practice M-F

- Poor weather is determined by coaches, and practices are held at MHS. Occasionally, coaches assign On Your Own workouts (OYOs).*
