

REFRESHER: TYPES OF VOLUNTEER ROLES

BOATHOUSE JACKET

For all those rowers who waited to order a boathouse jacket until you knew you were committed to crew - your time to order is now. We will be placing a boathouse order in the next few weeks, so they will arrive prior to the holidays. We do need a minimum order of 6.

What is a boathouse jacket? A pullover style, mid weight GorTex waterproof jacket with MCLEAN CREW on the back and your name monogramed on the front. AKA – a really cool crew jacket that keeps you dry on rainy days and just looking awesome on non-rainy days.

How must does it cost? \$256.50 – please note due to personalization all orders are final and cannot be returned. This is an optional uniform purchase.


