
Noxontown Regatta at St. Andrews March 30, 2024 Middletown, Delaware





GPS address for the venue: Rodney Point 560 Noxontown Road, Townsend DE 19734.

Note: Gates on the visitor side open at 8am. The location is <u>not</u> accessed via the school campus. Once you get to Noxontown Road, pass the school driveway and continue around the bend in the road and on your right, you will see Noxontown Pond. Turn right into the race and parking area <u>across the pond from the school</u>. Follow the "Crew" signs. Drive along the dirt road and look for the McLean tent.

The Venue – Rodney Point GPS address:

- 560 Noxontown Road, Middletown, DE 19734
- Estimated 2:15-2:30 hour ride (dependent on traffic).
- Location <u>not</u> accessed via the school campus.

Parking:

 Free parking is available at the Noxontown Pond area near the team tents.

Facilities:

- Race site offers only port-a-johns.
- O There is very little shelter.
- No potable water onsite; bring ample water for personal consumption.

Racing Time:

O 1:00 PM- approx. 4pm

Athletes Should Bring:

- O Wear what they are going to practice in on bus.
- Crew uni and long sleeve top for racing
- O Layers of clothes and rain gear
- Change of clothes for ride home
- O 2 bottles of water

Additional Helpful Information:

- Athletes should eat a good breakfast before departure and/or bring snacks for bus.
- Spectators are also encouraged to bring water. Team tent has coffee
- Upon arrival, efforts will be concentrated on unloading, derigging and practice. We will offer light breakfast at tent for team and parents.
- Hot lunch will be provided for team and parents
- The team tent will be available but remember to <u>bring a lawn chair or</u> <u>blanket for sitting</u>.
- Be prepared for changing weather hot and cold
- Parents may bring their athlete home with them <u>but must email</u> <u>their coach (Carol or Jack) in</u> advance

- 7:00 AM Buses arrive at MHS for loading (Eat breakfast before loading or bring snack for ride.)
- 7:15 AM Last call... All rowers at bus for loading
- 7:30 AM Buses depart MHS (Coaches Jack Connors and Carol Dinion to ride)
- 9:45-10:00 AM Buses arrive at St. Andrews

After arrival:

- Unload and rig boats
- 10:30 Light breakfast for team at tent
- Practice
