

Historian


 Maintain records of important MCC events; organize and document the club's history





CANADA ATHLETE AND PARENT LOGISTICS

- Athletes will need a photo id for Canadian Secondary Schools Rowing Association (CSSRA). They do daily id checks against lineups for racing.
- **Permission slips**, as well as proof of residency (e.g., US Passport), are required for return to the US.
- Spectators on the island **must be wearing a wristband** that may be purchased at the gate. Coaches and Athletes are provided with wristbands. The wristband gives access to the grandstand as well to watch races from the finish line.
- Team Tent will be booked with Robson Tents.



CANADA ACCOMODATIONS & MEALS

- Brock University, village townhouse residences, 1812 Sir Issac Brock Way, St. Catharines, Ontario L2S, 3A1. Phone: 905-688-5550
- Check in after 3PM, about a 20 minute drive from the race area. We have reserved townhouses each of which have a kitchen and 5 single beds arranged in 4 bedrooms. Linens (e.g., sheets and towels for each athlete), are included. A chaperone will be required in the townhomes.
- The chaperones will buy groceries for 3 breakfasts and snacks. Each athlete should also bring \$130 \$150 for 4 dinners out and lunch upon arrival. The best formats are a credit card that can be used internationally (currency conversation fees may apply) and the second choice would be Canadian dollars.
- Dinners will be at local restaurants as a group and arranged by MCC Board
