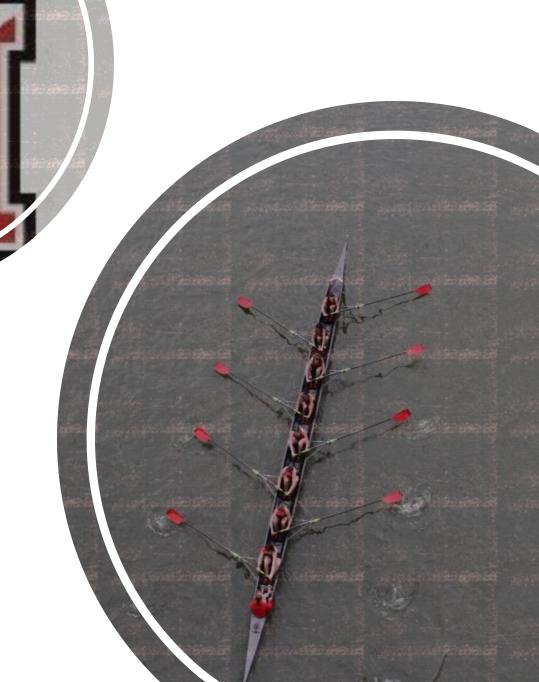

McLean Rowing Foundation

- Overview: 501(c)3 nonprofit organization that supports, facilitates and promotes the sport of rowing in the greater McLean, Virginia area
- **Problem**: Most crew teams receive no funding from the school district so joining a team can be financially out of reach for many kids. At McLean High School, 190 students (nearly 9%) received free or reduced priced meals (FRM*) during the 2018 2019 school year
- What We Do: Provide financial support to students who participate in the free and reducedprice lunch program. Learn to row, uniforms, and away regattas (e.g., Stotesbury, Nationals) are partially or fully paid by the foundation.
- What we've done: Supported 4 rowers over the past 3 years that would otherwise not have been able to row.
- Asks: 1) If you need support, contact us, 2) Donate gear for gear swapping, 3) Funding, we're good for now, and please consider the future.

^{*} FCPS FRM Criteria: Families who earn less than 130 percent of the poverty level are eligible for free meals and those with incomes between 130 and 185 percent of poverty level qualify for reduced-price meals.

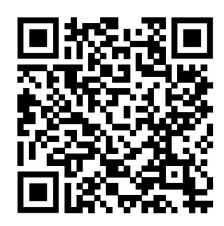

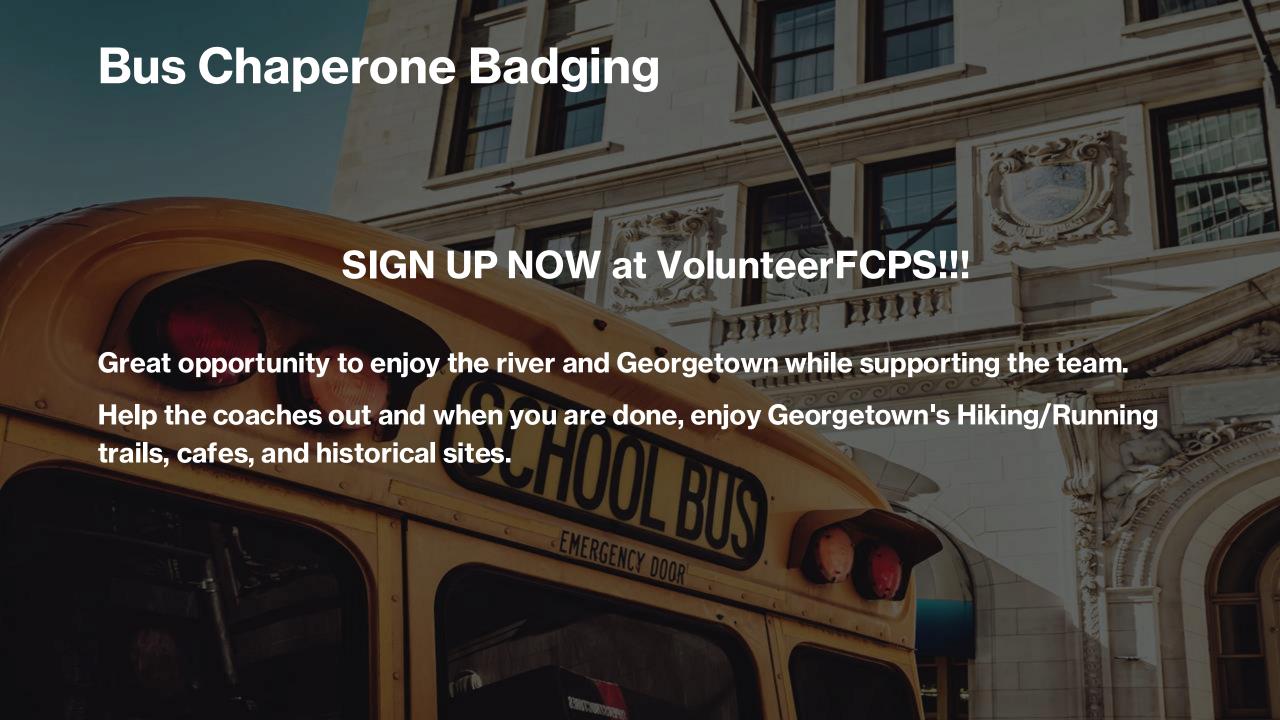

Volunteer to be a Bus Chaperone!

- Serving as a bus chaperone during the season is a great way to earn volunteer credits, and the kids can't practice at TBC unless we have two chaperones/day, one for the boys bus and one for the girls bus.
- To serve as a bus chaperone you must register with VolunteerFCPS, FCPS's new volunteer system as a Level 3 volunteer. Process is MUCH EASIER this year.
- Once registered, volunteers are granted a provisional approval to volunteer.
- FCPS will contact volunteers that require a background check and fingerprinting once Gatehouse clears through their backlog of applications.
- At the moment, no physical badges will be issued by FCPS.
- Xavi Slocum is the Badging Coordinator for the 2025-26 season.



WINTER CONDITIONING

Winter conditioning begins on Monday, November 24th.

Girls:

- 3:15 PM 5:15 PM, Monday Friday (Thursdays- On Your Own Workouts)
- 9:00 AM 11:00 AM, Saturday (9-10 Weight Room, 10-11 Ergs)

Girls will meet for practice at the crew shed (near door 12 at the back of the school) already dressed for practice.

Boys:

- 4:30 PM 6:30 PM, Monday Friday at MHS, Wednesday- Varsity Boys Zoom Learning session- Time: TBD by Coach Azim
- 8:00 AM 11:00 AM, Saturday (8-10 Ergs, 10-11 Weights)

Boys will meet in study hall and have the opportunity to change before practice.

Study Hall Days/Times for Boys:

- 3:15-4:30 Weekdays except Wednesday in **room S125.** Study hall is chaperoned by MHS Staff. Students will not be allowed to leave study hall and walk around the school. Study hall will not be held on non-school days.

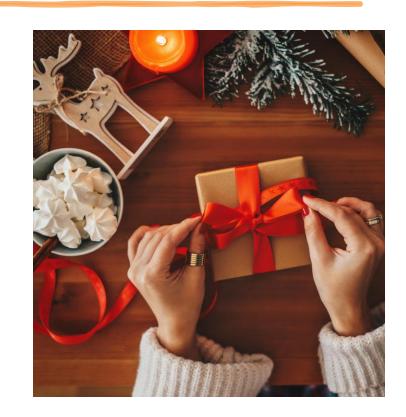

 Pledge Collection Begin
 - Mulch Sales Leads emailed
 - Ergathon Pledge sheets emailed
- Sat, Dec 13 MCC at Holiday Bazaar
- Sat, Jan 24 Ergathon, 9 am 1 pm
 - MANDATORY: Athlete
- Sat, Feb 28 & Sun, Mar 1 Mulch Delivery
 - MANDATORY: Athlete both days
 - MANDATORY: 1 parent at least 1 day
 - Mar 7-8 Blizzard backup weekend

PROVEN STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS:

- Email sales leads on Dec 12. Follow up every 2-3 weeks.
- Those who sell early, sell more.
- If you wait too long, you will lose leads.
- If customer doesn't want mulch, ask for a Pre-Ergathon cash donation!
- Canvas neighborhoods in small teams before Ergathon to cash donations.
- Both Pre-Ergathon cash donations and Mulch Sales can significantly lower an athlete's dues (50% cash donation and \$2 per mulch bag goes to own athlete's dues reduction)!
