## CANADIAN SECONDARY SCHOOLS ROWING ASSOCIATION (CSSRA)

- 78th Annual Regatta will be held at the Royal Canadian Henley Regatta Course
- Dates: Friday, May 30th, Sunday, June 2nd
- Livestream will be available <u>here;</u> Heat Sheets are <u>here</u>
- All coxswains and lightweight competitors must weigh in each day they race (Friday 6am-10am, Saturday 6am-9am, Sunday 6am-8am)
- Each athlete must be dressed in their racing uniform, have **Photo ID** in their Hand (either school issued photo ID or government issued photo ID with a birthdate), and know the time of their race(s)



## CSSRA SPECTATORS

- Spectators will require a wristband to access both the team tent on Henley Island and the Grandstands
- Adult Prices are \$12/1-day pass or \$30/3-day pass
- Team Tent is located at L14 on Henley Island
- The Grandstand is located at 65 Main Street, St. Catharines,
- Please stay away from the shell launching area. This is for Athletes, Coaches and Officials Only!
- No vehicles will have in and out access to the boat trailer area
- Dogs will not be allowed. This includes the island and grandstand. Only working licensed support dogs are the exception to the rule.
- Apparel, souvenirs & commemorative posters can be purchased on Henley Island



## TRANSPORTATION



- One 54-passenger charter bus will drive athletes and chaperones to and from St. Catharines, Ontario
- Athletes will load the bus at MHS on Thursday, May 29th ~5:30AM
- Athletes will return to MHS on Sunday,
   June 1st ~8PM 1AM
- There will be one chase car who will rendezvous with the bus in Buffalo on the way into CA and will follow the bus on the return trip from CA. This is important in case of any holdups at the border.

## ACTION REQUIRED

- Pay: You can pay online now. Total for the trip is \$820 which includes transportation, accommodations, groceries for breakfasts, catered lunches, dinners, registration fees and the cost for coaches and five (5) chaperones. Alternates will be refunded 50% if they do not row.
- **Sign:** Letter of Consent for Travel of a Minor Child via Docusign. Please complete it as soon as possible. Athletes need to carry a signed hard copy with wet signature(s) when boarding the bus (attached).

- Sign Up to Volunteer: We are asking ALL Parents planning to attend Canadian Nationals to help with at least one volunteer duty! See SUG Here
- Pack: Proof of residency and Wet Consent Letters in carry-on; COPIES are placed in the luggage
- Inform: Athletes must give all teachers advance notice regarding their absence from school on May 29th and May 30th (all day). The Board has provided the roster to the attendance office.
